ITEMS FOR ACTION/DISCUSSION

Approval of Meeting notes was postponed to a future meeting.

The meeting schedule for 2020 was discussed. The Board concluded that the weather and farming needs are difficult to predict and concluded by consensus that the meeting dates for 2020 will be scheduled on the fourth Thursday of the months of February, May and November. The fourth Thursday of September will be scheduled as a potential meeting date and will be used if needed or due to harvest or other conflicts that may affect attendance during other months, The final meeting of the year to be the second Thursday of December. Further, meeting locations will be determined by staff, rotate locations, and be held at locations near Interstate 5, unless a field trip or tour might be arranged for a project. River Partners presented information and a request for approval of a letter of concurrence with the Sacramento River Conservation Area Handbook for the acquisition of property. The parcel is known as Rancho Caleta is located in Colusa County at Butte Slough Road. The land is to be acquired from a willing seller and the organization is seeking funding from WCB. The current uses are orchard and riparian. River Partners has made some contacts with adjoining property owners finding no specific objections to date. The project is in its very early stages. The Board approved the letter of concurrence and requested River Partners to provide updates on funding, the land valuation process, communication with adjoining landowners and local government and the restoration planning. M by Hawes, S by Mat, unanimous.

Jane commented that with the loss of Ellen Gentry, staff is trying to keep up with the administrative paperwork and she is reviewing time needs and budget capacity for filling this position, which may only be part-time in the future.

Staff provided information of projects of Cooperative Agreement with USBR CVPIA Fisheries Habitat Improvement and Safe Harbor. Board members requested more detailed information of funding at future meeting(s).

Board members (county and agency) & guests provided brief, oral reports. Mike Berry reported that after four years of actions and projects to improve fish populations it has been found the work to construct side channels along the Upper Sacramento river to be a great benefit. He views the work, including our projects of creating juvenile habitat to be a good way to "turning the knob" and increase the population.
